- Only 15 responses
- ❖ 47% preferred Friday, 13% had no preference of Fri. vs. Sat.
 - > Many stated volunteering was easier on Saturday
- ❖ 87% preferred after school
- Most said food trucks should stay longer
- Needed an additional balloon artist
- Happy with prize selections
- Happy with communication
- Permission slips were a struggle
